TOUR ITINERARY

This carefully designed itinerary highlights Madrid's stunning culture and architecture alongside the Mutua Madrid Open's Day sessions. Enjoy optional group evening activities or explore the city at your own pace for a personalized experience.

Day 1: ¡Bienvenidos a Madrid!

Upon arrival at Adolfo Suárez Madrid-Barajas Airport, set off to Madrid's city centre via private transfer to the Pestana Plaza Mayor Boutique Hotel, situated in the heart of one of the city's most iconic squares. This 4-star hotel is steps away from major attractions like the Royal Palace, Puerta del Sol, and Gran Vía, offering the perfect base to explore Madrid. With luxurious amenities, a rooftop pool, and beautifully restored architecture, the hotel provides a peaceful retreat after your travels. Once checked in, take some time to unpack and unwind after your overnight flight.

Join the group for the first activity of the week. Meet for a welcome dinner to discuss the itinerary for the week.

Day 2: Mutua Madrid Open

Start your day with a delightful breakfast at Pestana Plaza Mayor, enjoying the charm of Madrid's historic center before a leaving by private vehicle for the renowned Caja Mágica. This state-of-the-art sports complex, designed by architect Dominique Perrault, is home to the Madrid Open and features multiple indoor and outdoor courts. Spend the day immersed in professional tennis action, watching matches and practices at the Caja Magica sports complex. Enjoy premium seating in the Estadio Manolo Santana with access to the additional courts throughout the facility. After an exciting day, a private transfer will return you to the hotel.

Optional Evening: Tapas Crawl in La Latina

Kick off your Madrid nights with a classic tapas crawl in the La Latina neighborhood. This area is known for its narrow streets and vibrant food scene. Pop in and out of various establishments savoring traditional tapas like patatas bravas and tortilla española paired with a glass of vermouth.

Day 3: Mutua Madrid Open

Start your day with breakfast at Pestana Plaza Mayor, before private transfer takes you to the renowned Caja Mágica. After a day of tennis, private transfer back to the hotel.

Evening Activity: Flamenco Show

Experience the passion and intensity of a traditional flamenco show, where vibrant dancers, soulful guitar music, and powerful vocals come together in a mesmerizing performance.

Day 4: Round of 16

After breakfast at the hotel, head off to the Madrid Open via private transfer to enjoy the Round of 16 match-ups. Enjoy premium seating in Estadio Manolo Santana with access to the complex grounds. After the excitement of the matches, you'll be transported back to the hotel.

Optional Evening: Mercado de San Miguel & Royal Palace by Night
Start with a visit to Mercado de San Miguel, a gourmet market where to sample local delicacies for dinner. Follow up with a nighttime walk around the Royal Palace and Almudena Cathedral. After the stroll, grab churros and hot chocolate at Chocolatería San Ginés, open late and a favorite among locals.

Day 5: Toledo and Winery

Depart Madrid for the beautiful Imperial city of Toledo, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the oldest cities in Europe. Known as the "city of the three cultures," Toledo is a place where Christians, Muslims, and Jews coexisted for centuries. With an expert guide, explore Toledo's rich history through its mix of Arabic, Gothic, Mudéjar, Renaissance, and Baroque architecture. Visit the Jewish Quarter and the convent area, discovering stories and legends from before the Muslim conquest. Highlights include a visit to the Cathedral of Toledo, a masterpiece of Spanish Gothic architecture.

Next stop: a Spanish vineyard. With the guidance of an oenologist, learn about the winemaking process, from the maturing of wine in barrels to the distinct aromas of the cellar. Conclude the visit with a wine tasting led by a sommelier, sampling the finest wines of the region. After an enriching day of history and flavor, you'll return to Madrid in a comfortable private vehicle.

In the evening, share a meal with the group and reminisce about the amazing memories made together in Madrid.

Day 6: Adios Madrid

The trip concludes with breakfast at Pestana Plaza Mayor.

Who is allowed to book this trip?

Individuals 21 and older can book the trip, with members receiving priority registration for 14 days due to limited availability.

How much does this cost?

The cost of the trip varies based accommodations.

Double Occupancy: \$2440 USD

Single Occupancy: \$3270 USD

What is Mutua Madrid Open experience like?

Estadio Manolo Santana has a seating capacity of 12,442.

The tickets at Estadio Manolo Santana are in the middle level, offering a perfect balance of proximity to the action and an elevated view. These tickets give access to all other courts except stadium 2. Surrounding the 3 main courts are smaller courts for matches, warm-up, and practices, shopping boutiques, cafes, bars, lounges, and various fan experiences.

Can I upgrade my tickets to Platinum seating?

Yes, of course.

Saturday & Sunday: Add \$249 USD per day

Monday: Add \$319 USD

The ticket difference must be paid with your registration deposit and is non-refundable.

What's excluded in package?

- International airfare to/from Madrid
- Travel Insurance which we offer and can be purchased
- Passport, visa fees, arrival/departure taxes (if any)
- Personal room charges for laundry, room service, hotel dining, and spa services
- Optional evening activities
- Pre-arrival or post-departure accommodations

What if I am a solo traveler?

This trip is perfect for solo travelers, with double or single occupancy options. We'll pair you with a same-gender solo traveler for double occupancy, or you can opt for single occupancy for an extra fee.

I want to go! What do I do next?

To secure your spot, complete the registration forms and submit the non-refundable \$500 fee per person. Verbal commitments are not accepted due to limited availability.

When do I pay for my trip balance?

Balance must be paid in three equal installments.

Payment 1: November 15

Payment 2: January 15

Payment 3: February 15

What types of payment do you accept?

ACH/Check: No additional fees

Visa, MasterCard, Amex, Discover

Credit Card: 4% transaction fee

What is the cancellation policy?

You can cancel up to 30 days before the start of the trip for a full refund minus the non-refundable deposit of \$500. Cancellations prior to the 30 day of the start date will receive a 50% refund.

Refunds will be transmitted through ACH within 7 days of cancellation notice.

What is the nearest airport?

Madrid's international airport is Adolfo Suárez Madrid-Barajas Airport (Aeropuerto Adolfo Suárez Madrid-Barajas). It is commonly referred to as Madrid-Barajas and is the main airport serving the city.

Airport Code: MAD

What time should I arrive in Madrid?

We recommend arriving early to check-in, unpack, and rest before our first activity at 6:00 pm. Hotel check-in is at 3:00 pm, but they can hold your luggage if you wish to explore the area.

Do I need a visa?

Beginning the spring of 2025, members of the Schengen region (including Spain) will require a new visa for U.S. citizens called the ETIAS.

Will the itinerary change?

Please be aware that the itinerary, activities, and hotels are subject to change. These changes are rare but can happen with little notice due to availability, poor weather, seasonal changes, or other circumstances beyond our control – but we'll always do our best to ensure it has little impact on your experience.

Do I need to travel insurance?

While travel insurance is not required for this trip, we strongly recommend purchasing it to cover any unforeseen cancellations, medical issues, or other circumstances.

Are airport transfers included?

If you arrive on Day 1 of your adventure, or you book pre-tour accommodation with us, your airport arrival transfer will be included. If you book alternative pre-tour accommodation or are arriving by another mode of transport you must arrange your own arrival transfer.

Arrival transfers are private to our travelers and will be in groups depending on flight times. Sometimes this means waiting in the airport for a short while until other flights have arrived.

We don't offer a departure transfer as most travellers leave at different times of the day and many stay for extra nights. We will offer you support with finding a local taxi, metro assistance, or scheduling a private transfer.

What time should I depart Madrid?

The time you chose to depart is a personal preference but the hotel's check-out time is 12:00 pm.
